Course start dates

All Part Time courses are available for September entry. January availability is reliant upon the course structure permitting a January start and vacancies being available. This information is usually available from November, please contact the Admissions Office at this time to confirm availability. Please note that if you enrol as a Part Time student a request to change to Full Time cannot be considered until one academic year has elapsed.

Course Costs

Part Time fees are per year and cover 4 module credits, an additional charge is paid for a fifth module credit. Fees can be found on the Student Finance Office website, please be aware that there are two levels of Fees, dependant upon the level of qualification you already hold.
