

What To Expect...

You will take part in ESOL English lessons every day (Mondays to Fridays). These lessons will include learning about grammar, sentence structure and new vocabulary. You will practise the skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing through different projects and exercises.

On your first day take a tour of the college campus to see some of the facilities on offer to you during your time as a Summer School student. These include the canteen, which caters for specialist diets including vegetarian and Halal options, a well-stocked library, multi-faith room, sports fitness centre and IT facilities including free internet access.

By the end of the Summer School our students feel more confident with speaking and using English. On the last day of the Summer School, you will be presented with an English Language course certificate from Solihull College & University Centre and enjoy a party to celebrate what you have learned.

You will need to know some English in order to obtain a place on this course, and must be aged 16+. You will have an assessment to find your current level, so that activities can be tailored to your needs.
